

STUDYING WITH THE FEYNMAN TECHNIQUE

Steps: 1) Identify your concept; 2) explain it as if you are teaching someone else (e.g., an 8-10 year old); 3) highlight the areas you struggled with; 4) go relearn those trouble areas; 5) come back and reexplain the topic; 6) double check your final wording to make sure complicated terms are simplified.
